Baldwinsville, located in Onondaga County, New York, is a charming village situated along the Seneca River. The river has been integral to the village's development. A significant feature in Baldwinsville... which the locals call "B'ville"... is Lock 24 of the New York State Canal System which opened in 1910.

The Seneca River itself is named after the Seneca people, one of the indigenous nations of the Iroquois Confederacy. Historically, the river served as an important trade route for Native Americans communities long before European settlers arrived.


Instead, plan for rates to settle in the mid-6% range by year-end.
